Positioning:

DX: Rhinorrhea- Patient prone

Patients with Otorrhea:

- Use Temporal Bone CT protocol
- Pre-scan before intrathecal injection (Bone: 1mm, ax (raw))
- Post intrathecal contrast injection, target side of interest only for ax and cor
- No Poschl or Stenvers
- Review images with onsite radiologist before releasing patient
